# Access more with expanded smart search results

Smart search is now **generally available** on the Appian platform.

Smart search now returns up to 10 semantic matches from both document fields and long text fields, and works with larger datasets—search extra-long text fields (up to 500,000 rows) and other text fields (up to 1.5 million rows).

# New distribution method for confirmation script

The *configure.sh* script used by server administrators has been relocated as a standalone artifact on Forum that can be downloaded by customers.

This change helped reduce the artifacts size of Appian installers, and allows for more streamlined access to the configure script itself.



# Better compatibility with Kubernetes platforms

Appian on Kubernetes images are now more compatible with Kubernetes platforms that specify or assign arbitrary user IDs at runtime.

This ensures Appian on Kubernetes runs in environments with strict security policies, such as OpenShift's Security Context Constraints (SCCs).



# 25.3 is the last supported non-containerized version

Starting with Appian 25.4, all new versions of Appian will **require containers managed by Kubernetes to run in a self-managed environment**. You won't be able to obtain Windows or Linux installers for Appian for 25.4 and its hotfixes.

Appian 25.3 will be the **last supported non-containerized version** and will be supported with hotfixes and critical updates for two years after release (Fall 2027).
