 - Appian is providing a special 24.2 EA Appian cloud environment into which Community members can log in via SSO.
 - You will be assigned a unique Workspace Identifier Prefix during onboarding to the cloud environment. Please use this Identifier as a prefix in front of all objects and when submitting your final hackathon submission. Put your final application objects in a single app package that is labeled (your prefix - ex: **WXXXX Hackathon Submission**). Use the submission form on your environment homepage <https://hackathon.appian.community/suite/sites/home> (available on or about 6-May-2024).
 - Please email community@appian.com with any questions, including requests for plugins to be added to <https://hackathon.appian.community/>.
- **Submission:** The goal of the Hackathon is to help Appian developers make beautiful UIs, efficiently, by creating a new AppMarket Utility with inspirational form & scalable function. Additionally, we will ask you for the following information when you submit your entry:
 - App Name
 - App Description, including Key Features & Functionality
 - 1-8 Screenshots and an icon that both meet the official [AppMarket Guidelines](#)
 - Additional (up to 2) team member names (if applicable). The primary team member should submit the entry and will be responsible for communication with the Appian team.

Hackathon Timeline

- **Submission Period:** April 29, 2024 to May 24, 2024
- **Judging Period:** May 25, 2024 to May 31, 2024
- **Livestream Announcing Winners:** June 5, 2024

Hackathon Prizes

- **Implementation of the Idea.** This is where your idea takes flight. How well is your concept executed? Does it glide smoothly into deployment with a clear and consistent deployment pattern, or does it need a little push?
- **Potential Impact of the Idea.** We're dreaming big—because why not? How far can your Utility go in accelerating development for the community? Will it be the wind beneath our wings, making everything we do faster, smoother, better? That's the kind of impact we're aiming for.

2024 APPIAN COMMUNITY HACKATHON OFFICIAL RULES

The Appian Community Hackathon (“**ACH**”) is a promotion offered by Appian Corporation and its affiliates and licensors (collectively referred to as “**We**”, “**Us**” or “**Our**”). It allows eligible participants, as more particularly described below (“**You**” or “**Your**”), to submit a utility (“**Submission**”) developed using Our software platform (“**Appian Platform**”), which will be judged by Us and, if meeting certain criteria, will make You eligible to receive certain prizes described below. The ACH will be conducted pursuant to these Official Rules (“**Official Rules**”).

YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO MAKE ANY PURCHASE OR TO MAKE ANY PAYMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ACH. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. THE ACH IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

BY PARTICIPATING IN THE ACH, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE OFFICIAL RULES. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES OR IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO BIND YOUR TEAM OR ORGANIZATION, AS APPLICABLE, TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, YOU MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE ACH.

1. Hackathon Period. The ACH runs from April 29th, 2024 at 10:00 AM Eastern Standard Time through May 24th at 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time (“**Hackathon Period**”).

2. Eligibility. To be eligible to participate in the ACH, You and every member of Your team or organization, if applicable, must satisfy each of the following:

- be at least age 18
- not be from any part of the world where We are not licensed to do business, unable to lawfully export the Appian Platform, or where the ACH is unlawful
- not be a resident of, or an organization domiciled in Brazil, Quebec, Cuba, Sudan, Iran, North Korea, Syria and any other country in which We are prohibited from doing business by applicable law
- not be Our employees, Judges (as defined below) or persons or entities employed by or employing a Judge, or **employees or immediate family members of Our competitors**
- not, in Our sole discretion, be an individual or organization whose participation in the ACH would create a real or apparent conflict of interest or competitive conflict

3. How To Enter. You must complete the specifically-designated hackathon cloud environment (<https://hackathon.appian.community/>) registration process and submit your project by completing the Hackathon submission form to be eligible to participate in the ACH. By participating, You consent to Our collecting and maintaining Your personal information for the purpose of operating the ACH and publicizing the ACH, pursuant to these Official Rules and Our published [privacy policy](#).

4. Access to the Appian Platform. To develop a Submission, You will need access to a specifically-designated development environment of the Appian Platform (<https://hackathon.appian.community/>). Your use of the Appian Platform will be subject to a separate license agreement between You and Us. See <https://community.appian.com/challenges> for details on obtaining access to the Hackathon developer environment.

5. Team Representation. If You are entering the ACH as a team or organization, You must appoint and authorize one individual (the **"Representative"**) to represent and act on Your behalf. Teams are expressly limited to no more than **3** individuals. Any team Submission must be entered on Your behalf by the Representative. The Representative must meet the eligibility requirements above. The individual entering a Submission to the ACH represents and warrants that he or she is the Representative authorized to act on behalf of Your team or organization.

6. Submission Requirements. Submissions must meet the following requirements:

- be built using the Appian Platform with the goal of creating a working app to be shared with the Appian Developer Community via design.appian.com and/or as a Utility on the Appian AppMarket (community.appian.com/b/appmarket). Your submission must include the following:
 - Built on Appian [24.2](#) EA in the official Hackathon Appian cloud environment (<https://hackathon.appian.community/>)
 - A reusable UI similar to the Inspiration examples found on design.appian.com
 - Includes the use of [translation sets](#) for easy internationalization
 - Includes easily replaceable sample data for generalized use
 - At least 1 new [Interface Component](#) from Appian [23.4+](#)
- be a new Submission or an update created during the Hackathon Period to an existing Submission to the Appian AppMarket. If an update to an existing Submission, the Submission will be judged solely on the basis of the update and You will be required to explain how the utility has been updated during the Hackathon Period.
- function as depicted in the text description.
- be in English.
- be Your original work, be solely owned by the You, or be other material You have permission to use pursuant to these Official Rules.
- be provided as a working application that must exist in the official 2024 Appian Community Hackathon environment.
- be provided to Us at no charge for the testing and judging and applicable display periods.
- comply with the requirements to be posted on the Appian AppMarket as a Utility.
- You may submit more than one Submission, however, each Submission must be unique and substantially different from each of Your other Submissions, as determined by Us in Our sole discretion.
- If a Submission uses the integration SDK, APIs and/or data, You must be authorized to use them and allow Us to use them for the purpose of judging and displaying such Submission.

7. Submission Modifications.

A. Modifications After the Hackathon Period. We may permit You to modify part of Your Submission after the Hackathon Period to remove material that potentially infringes a third party mark or right, discloses personally identifiable information, or is otherwise inappropriate. The modified Submission must remain substantively the same as the original Submission with the only modification being that what We permit.

8. Judges & Criteria. Eligible Submissions will be evaluated by a panel of judges selected by Us ("**Judges**"). Judges may be Our employees or third parties, may or may not be listed individually on Our website, and may change before or during the period during which the Submissions will be judged pursuant to the ACH ("**Judging Period**"). Judging may take place in one or more rounds with one or more panels of Judges, at Our discretion. Submissions will be evaluated on the following criteria, and according to the Judges' sole and absolute discretion:

- Quality of the idea underlying the Submission (creativity, originality, and reusability of the idea)
- Implementation of the idea underlying the Submission (how well the idea was executed by You)
- Potential Impact (how the Submission can positively impact the developer Community)

The three (3) Submissions earning the highest overall scores based on the judging criteria will become potential winners of the first, second and third place prizes described below. Judges are not required to test a Submission and may choose to judge based solely on the description, images and any additional artifacts provided with a Submission. For each prize, if two or more Submissions are tied, the Submission with the highest score in the first judging criterion (quality of idea) will be considered the higher scoring Submission. In the event any ties remain, this process will be repeated, as needed, by comparing the tied Submissions' scores on the next applicable criterion. If two or more Submissions are tied on all applicable judging criteria, the panel of Judges will vote on a winner of the tied Submissions.

9. Intellectual Property Rights. All Submissions remain Your intellectual property, except that We reserve all rights in the Appian Platform. By submitting a Submission, You grant Us a worldwide, irrevocable, sublicensable, transferable, fully paid, non-exclusive license to use the Submission for judging the entry and to display and make available the Submission on the Appian AppMarket free of charge. Nothing prevents or limits Us from marketing or selling anything that is substantially similar to Your Submission. You authorize Us to use Your name, likeness, voice and image to promote or publicize the ACH and its results during the Hackathon Period and for three years thereafter, subject to our posted privacy policy. You agree that we may publicly display the following Submission components: Submission description, Submission images, Submission video URL (if provided), and any other aspect of the submission. By submitting a Submission, You represent and warrant that (a) the submitted content is not copyrighted, protected by trade secret or otherwise subject to third party intellectual property rights or other proprietary rights, including privacy and publicity rights, unless You are the owner of such rights or You have permission from the rightful owner to post the content; and (b) the content submitted does not contain any viruses, trojan horses, worms, spyware or other disabling devices or harmful or malicious code. We maintain all right, title, and interest in any Background Intellectual Property. "Background Intellectual Property" means any registered and unregistered proprietary methodologies, tools, software, documentation, know-how, trade secrets, inventions, copyrights, or works of authorship, or any other intellectual property conceived or developed by Us.

10. Prizes. ACH prizes are non-transferable by the winner. Prize winners will be solely responsible for all applicable taxes related to accepting the prize.

11. Prize Winners. There is a limit of one (1) prize per person or team or organization. Winners will be notified on or about 7 days after the Hackathon Period ends. THE AWARD OF A PRIZE TO A POTENTIAL WINNER IS SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION OF THE IDENTITY, QUALIFICATIONS AND ROLE OF THE POTENTIAL WINNER. Each winner or member of a winning team/organization (as applicable) may be required to complete, sign, have notarized (if applicable) and return to the address specified by Us, without alteration and in the form presented by Us, an affidavit of eligibility, declaration and/or liability/publicity release (unless prohibited by law) and tax forms (if applicable) or the prize may be forfeited. Winners must return required forms within ten (10) business days after the forms are sent. In the event of noncompliance with these requirements, the prize may be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner (time permitting and in Our sole discretion) based on the Judges' scores. The affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release (if any) are subject to verification by Us. We reserve the right to modify the notification procedures in connection with the selection of any alternate potential winner, if any.

Prizes will be payable to You, if an individual, or to Your Representative, if You are a team or organization. Your Representative is responsible for allocating the prize among Your team or organization's participating members, as the Representative deems appropriate. A monetary prize will be mailed to Your address (if You are an individual) or the Representative's address (if You are a team or organization), or wired to Your Representative, or organization's bank account, only after receipt of the required forms.

12. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, YOU AGREE TO INDEMNIFY, RELEASE, AND HOLD US AND OUR EMPLOYEES, DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS HARMLESS FROM ANY LIABILITY WHATSOEVER WITH RESPECT TO CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF YOUR PARTICIPATION IN OR OUR OPERATION (INCLUDING JUDGING AND DETERMINATIONS OF ELIGIBILITY) OF THE ACH. IF YOU WIN A PRIZE, YOU AGREE THAT THE PRIZE IS PROVIDED AS-IS WITHOUT ANY WARRANTY, REPRESENTATION OR GUARANTEE, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, IN FACT OR IN LAW.

SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN WARRANTIES OR THE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY. ACCORDINGLY, SOME OR ALL OF THE ABOVE EXCLUSIONS OR LIMITATIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU, AND YOU MAY HAVE ADDITIONAL RIGHTS.

13. Dispute Resolution/Governing Law. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, by participating in the ACH, You agree that any action at law or in equity initiated by any person or entity against Us or any person or entity affiliated with Us arising out of or relating to these Official Rules or the ACH shall be filed exclusively in the courts of County of Fairfax, Commonwealth of Virginia, and You hereby consent and submit to the personal and exclusive jurisdiction of such courts for the purposes of litigating any such action, with any right of change of venue or forum non conveniens or the like being expressly waived. Any such action shall be resolved individually, NOT as part of a class action; and any claims/judgments/awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but NOT attorneys' fees (or damages/remedies/relief of any other kind). These Official Rules and the ACH shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia without regard to choice of law/conflict of law principles of the Commonwealth of Virginia or any other jurisdiction.

15. Miscellaneous. We may change the Official Rules at any time, including Your and Our rights or obligations under the Official Rules. We will post the terms and conditions of the amended Official Rules on the appropriate areas of Our website. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, any amendment will become effective at the time specified in the posting of the amended Official Rules or, if no time is specified, the time of posting. We reserve the right, in Our sole discretion, to cancel, suspend and/or modify the ACH, or any part of it, in the event of a technical failure, fraud, or any other factor or event that was not anticipated or is not within Our control. In addition to the Official Rules, Your use of Our website shall be subject to the applicable terms of use appearing on such website, Your use of the Appian Platform shall be subject to separately negotiated license terms between You and Us, and Our use of Your personal information shall be subject to Our privacy policy, also appearing on our website. Except as noted above, the Official Rules represents the entire agreement between You and Us relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior oral and written communications and agreements. The waiver by either party of a breach or right under these Official Rules will not constitute a waiver of any other or subsequent breach or right. If any provision of these Official Rules is found unenforceable, it and any related provisions will be interpreted to best accomplish the unenforceable provision's essential purpose.
